SIXTH ROUND STRAY VACANCY ALLOTMENT TO
AYURVEDA/HOMOEEO/SIDDHA/UNANI AND
MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES

FACILITY TO REGISTER NEW OPTIONS

Vacancies in Medical and Medical Allied Courses that have arisen in various Government/Self Financing Colleges after the Fifth Phase Stray Allotment will be filled up through Sixth Phase Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment. Candidates who are included in the Kerala State Medical Rank List published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register fresh options till **10.01.2025, 3:00 PM**. Candidates who have submitted online application for Ayush courses to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as per notification dated 08.01.2025 or as per earlier notifications can also register options, however only those eligible candidates who are included in the revised Kerala State Merit List will be considered for allotment.

Candidates, in order to participate in the online stray vacancy filling allotment can register options through the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** by clicking the menu '**Stray Vacancy Option Registration**' available in the **Home page**. Since the probable vacancies that may arise during the course of stray vacancy filling allotment will also be included in the same seat allotment process, candidates shall give options to all colleges and courses which they are desirous of joining if allotted, irrespective of the current vacancy status. Seats under any category/quota un-availed by candidates from the same category/quota will be subjected to applicable category/quota conversion rules as per existing prospectus conditions or directions from the competent authority.

Guidelines for Stray Vacancy Filling

- Candidates who got allotment or joined the allotted seat in the third round/previous stray vacancy allotments are not eligible for participating in the sixth phase stray vacancy allotment.
- Candidates who are still continuing in admitted status consequent on previous allotments (Phase I, phase II, Phase III, Previous Stray Vacancy Allotments) are not eligible for participating in Sixth Round Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment.
- The ineligible candidates as per the list issued by AACCC will not be considered for the Sixth stray round allotment in the State.
- The seat received through stray vacancy allotment cannot be changed further at any instance.

Registration fee

Those candidates who wish to register options in Sixth Round Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment will have to pay the following registration fees to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The registration fee can be paid online or through Head Post Office to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations before registering options. The list of Head Post Offices is given in the website.

- The Option Registration fee for General/SEBC candidates is Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) and it has to be paid to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as prescribed above in order to access the online Option Registration portal.
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home have to pay only Rs. 500/- as the Option Registration fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- The registration fee of those candidates who get an allotment through Stray Vacancy filling will be carried over to Tuition Fee and the registration fee of those candidates who will not get any allotment will be refunded.
- The registration fee of those candidates who do not join the seat within the stipulated time will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Such students will also be penalized as per KEAM Prospectus clause 12.2.4.
- The registration fee of those candidates who quit seats after taking admission through stray vacancy filling will also be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Such students will also be penalized as per KEAM Prospectus clause 12.2.4.

- Candidates should give options only to the courses and colleges where they wish to study, if they get an allotment.

Fees

The details of fee for the Ayurveda / Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2024-25 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing colleges, those candidates who get allotment in Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2023-24 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2024-25 is going to be higher than that of 2023-24 for these colleges.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home need not pay the fee at the time of admission. **However, if such candidates are allotted under Management quota seats in Self-Financing Ayush colleges, they will have to remit the fee as shown in the allotment memo and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.**
